## County and City orders may be more restrictive for real estate services. List of City Orders by County

April 6, 2020

County and city orders relating to restrictions on real estate services may be more restrictive than the state rules. IMPORTANT: To assure compliance local and county as well as state restrictions must be checked.

This list contains available city orders relating to real estate's status as an essential service. The cities are listed by county. More cities are being added as we become aware of them. However, MANY CITIES AND COUNTIES ARE CHANGING THEIR GUIDANCE/ORDERS BASED ON LOCAL EVENTS. These change daily and sometimes hourly. It is important to use these lists with caution and still check the local city and county sites for any updated orders and guidance. C.A.R. has issued guidance on the state requirements and have issued <u>Best Practices</u> and Guidelines. These state guidelines do NOT supercede more restrictive city or county orders. We are attempting to keep this information current but it is important to check individually before relying on the information.
